Pronouns

A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun.

Commonly used pronouns: **you, he, she, it, we, us, our, I, me, they, them, him, her**

Pronoun My mother rented a videogame for **my brother and me**.

Example: My mother rented a videogame for **us**.

Object pronouns replace the person or thing affected with: **me, you, him, her, it, us, or them**.

Tip Subject pronouns replace who or what the sentence is about with: **I, you, he, she, it, we or they**.

Possessive pronouns replace a noun and show ownership: **mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs**.
