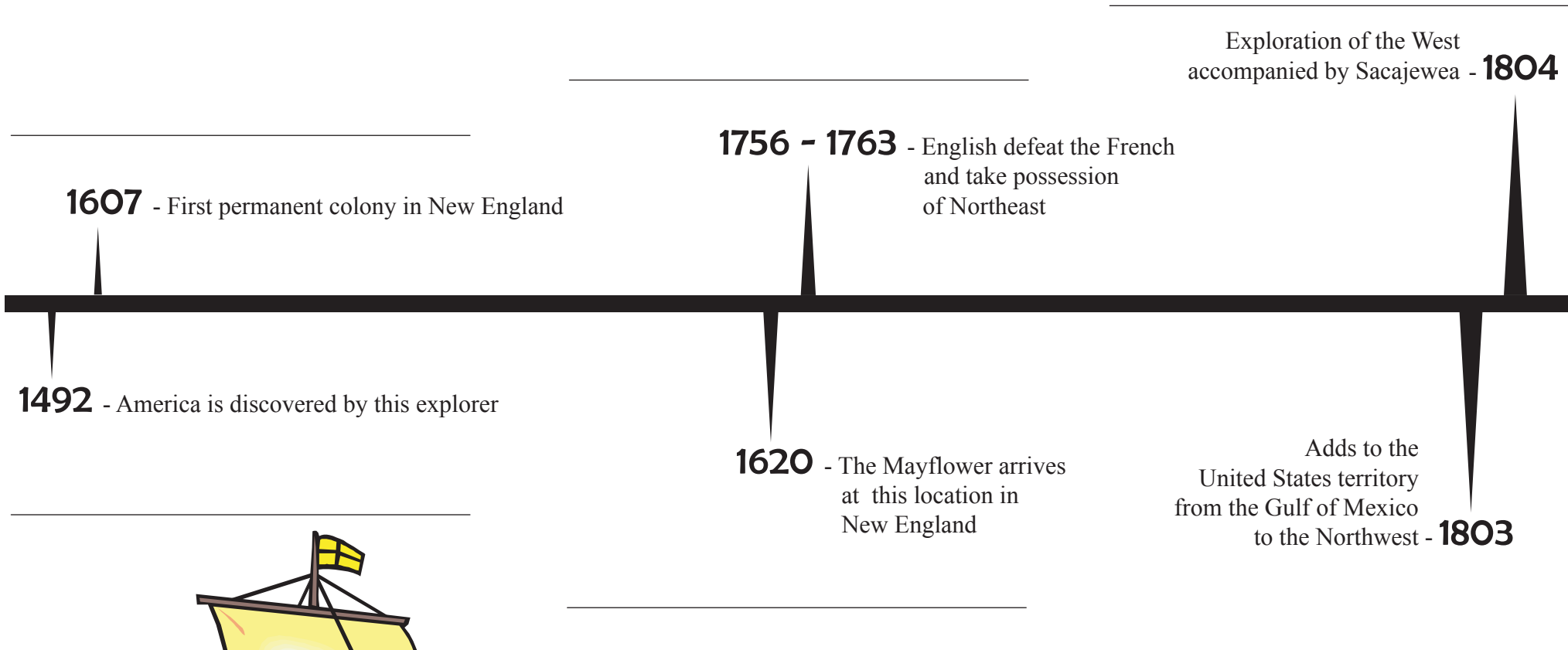

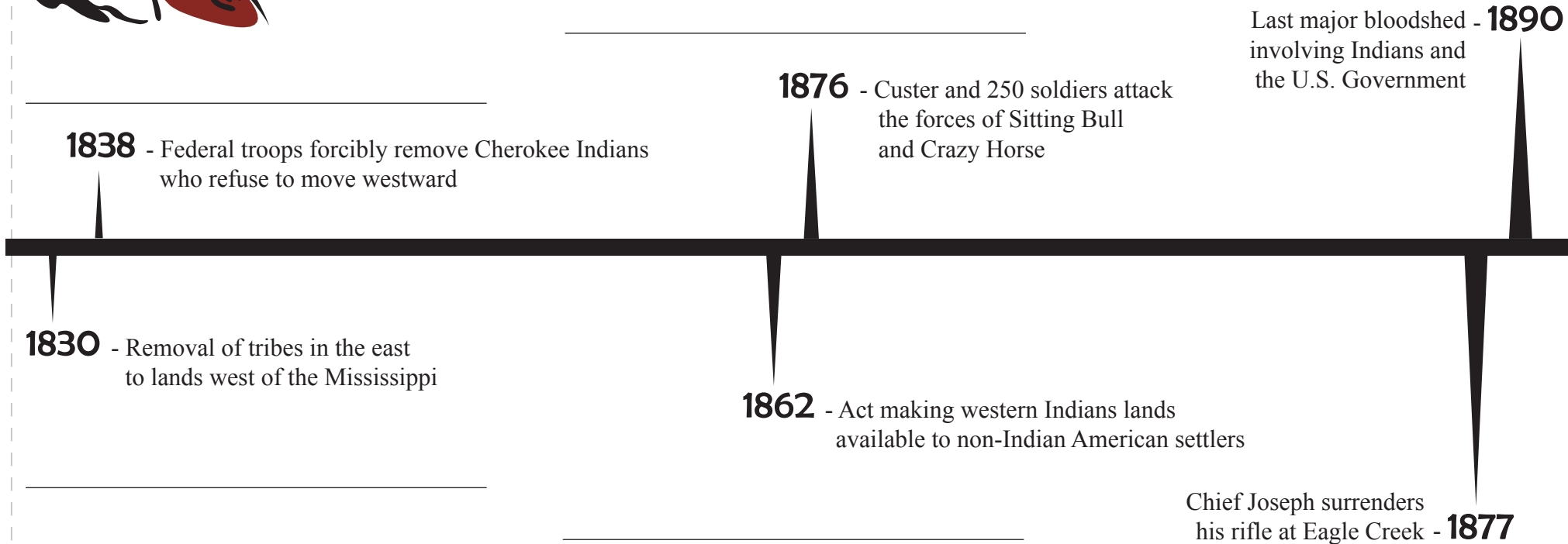

## Jamestown, Virginia

1607 - First permanent colony in New England

## French and Indian War

1756 - 1763 - English defeat the French and take possession of Northeast

## Lewis and Clark Expedition

Exploration of the West accompanied by Sacajewea - 1804

1492 - America is discovered by this explorer

## Christopher Columbus

1620 - The Mayflower arrives at this location in New England

Adds to the United States territory from the Gulf of Mexico to the Northwest - 1803

## Trail of Tears

**1838** - Federal troops forcibly remove Cherokee Indians who refuse to move westward

## Battle of the Little Bighorn

**1876** - Custer and 250 soldiers attack the forces of Sitting Bull and Crazy Horse

## Wounded Knee

Last major bloodshed - **1890** involving Indians and the U.S. Government

**1830** - Removal of tribes in the east to lands west of the Mississippi

## Indian Removal Act

**1862** - Act making western Indians lands available to non-Indian American settlers

## Homestead Act

Chief Joseph surrenders his rifle at Eagle Creek - **1877**
